# For 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students ONLY

- Read and fill out the top half Athletic PE Contract. Obtain signatures for #1, #2, and #3
   only.
- 2. Deliver the form to the LCCHS Counseling office.
- 3. Your counselor will add you to an 8th period PE Class.
- 4. At the end of the season, the LCC Athletics Office will receive coach confirmation that the athlete has completed the season <u>in good-standing</u> (i.e eligibility, finished the entire season, attended 90% of practices and games, good sportsmanship, etc).
- 5. Five (5) PE credits will be issued in the student's semester transcript following the conclusion of the season (i.e. credit for fall sports issued in first semester transcript; credit for winter & spring sports issued in second semester transcript).

# Q: How many athletic PE credits can you earn?

A: You can get up to 20 credits for participating in athletics; 5 credits per sport/10 max per year.
