CAL GRANT "OPT-OUT" FORM

For Seniors ONLY

With the implementation of Assembly Bill 2160, California public high schools are required to submit a Cal Grant high school Grade Point Average (GPA) for all graduating seniors, unless the student or parent has opted-out of the submission process.

Cal Grant gives funds to every eligible senior student who meets the requirement. A Cal Grant pays for tuition, room and board, or books and other supplies for California colleges. **Cal Grant applicants must file the FAFSA or the California Dream Act application between October 1, 2016 and March 2, 2017.**

If you **DO NOT** wish to have your student's information submitted electronically, you must complete the opt-out information below and return to:

This form must be returned by December 1, 2016. After that date, the information for all Seniors, excluding those who opt-out, will be submitted electronically to the California Student Aid Commission for Cal Grant consideration.

I realize that by opting-out, my student **WILL NOT** be considered for a Cal Grant award.
