Rank: LCCHS does not rank students. Simply put “NA” on your application.

SSID number: This is located on the bottom left of your transcript and called your “State ID #.”

What GPA do I use? For the UC’s and CSU’s you will use your 10-12 academic weighted GPA. For all other universities you will use your 9-12 total weighted GPA.

Where/When do I get a transcript?

Common App – Transcripts will be sent through Naviance by your counselor.

UC’s and CSU’s – No transcript required initially- only once you get an email from UC or CSU requesting you to send it. Then you request it through the LCC Registrar.

Non-Common App requiring a letter of recommendation- You are responsible for ordering a transcript from the registrar and mailing it or giving it to your counselor to mail with your letter of recommendation.

Non-Common App NOT requiring a letter of recommendation – You will order one from the Registrar and give them a stamped envelope with the address of the university admission office.

When do I need an envelope?

Common App – No envelope required.

UC’s and CSU’s – No envelope required if you are picking it up from the registrar to mail yourself. Otherwise, you supply a stamped addressed envelope to the college/s to be mailed by the registrar.

Non-Common App requiring a letter of recommendation – An envelope is required. The envelope needs to be 8 ½ x 11 with three stamps addressed to the University with the LCCHS mailing address as the return address. An evaluator form should be included- if applicable.

Non-Common App NOT requiring a letter or recommendation – No envelope required.

When do I send my test scores

As soon as you are done with testing and you have your list of colleges. Go to www.collegeboard.com to send SAT scores and www.act.org for ACT scores

~Remember to have your transcript with you when you are completing your application and to list all of the high schools you attended. Do not use Aeries transcript online to complete your application. Do not use plus and minus grades.~
