Schedule Adjustment Guidelines

<u>Choose your courses wisely.</u> The choices you make now will determine your 2018-2019 schedule. Keep in mind courses may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or staffing restrictions. Schedule changes <u>will not</u> be made to accommodate teacher requests, off-campus classes, or extracurricular and athletic activities.

<u>Mandatory schedule changes</u> will be made for students who completed an approved summer school course or for students who failed a course.

Adding/Dropping courses: requests will be considered during August school business days if:

- it improves integrity of schedule for graduation or college eligibility purposes.
- or if there is space available in an elective class during the same period as the dropped course.

After the first day of school, requests will require a conference with an administrator. If approved, the student may be required to make up missed work.

<u>Level changes</u> will be considered during the first **four weeks** of the semester, <u>if there is space available</u>. Prior to any level change being made, student and parent/guardian must have contact with current teacher.
