

INSTRUCTIONAL MINUTES



We encourage students to take advantage of all 7 periods. Some students may choose to take 7, 6 or 5 classes.

What is the minimum # of courses a student can take?

6 classes	5 classes
	The unscheduled period MUST be period 1 AND 2

If you sign up for an unscheduled period we must have a parent/guardian signature on file.

Read the Schedule Adjustment Guidelines and choose your courses wisely.

All classes are YEAR-LONG.

Schedule changes will *not* be made to accommodate:

- -teacher requests
- -off-campus classes
- -extracurricular and athletic activities.

Mandatory schedule changes *will* be made for students who:

- -Complete an approved summer school course.
- -Earn a D or F in math or world language second semester this year.
- -Need a specific course to meet a requirement to graduate.

SCHOOL BUSINESS DAYS

Adding/Dropping courses: during School Business Days (August) is considered if:

- 1. It improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college eligibility purposes.
- 2. There is space available in an elective class during the same period as the dropped course.

After the first day of school, requests will require a conference with an administrator. If approved, the student may be required to make up missed work.

WHEN WILL I MEET WITH MY COUNSELOR?

You will meet individually with your counselor at this time. It is very important that you have alternates for each elective class chosen.
