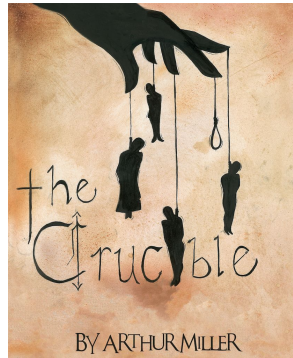

The numbers are in, and this year's annual fundraiser to support LCC teacher grants, **The Taste of La Costa**, was a great success! Held this past Saturday, November 12th, from 6pm~10pm, 83 guests enjoyed savoring some local delights, sipping on some of San Diego's famed microbrews and wines, supported our Arts and Academics via a Live and Silent Auction, *and* a Wine raffle, and then danced the night away under the stars.

Together with the Taste of La Costa Online Auction (which was open to the entire LCC community, and was a first for LCC), preliminary results show that the entire event netted about \$30,000, which will go straight to funding some of our teacher grant requests. Requests came in for almost \$400,000 this year, and a large proportion of those were to support STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)

education. Your generosity and commitment to LCC will be doubly rewarded, because our children are the ultimate recipients of the Foundation's fundraising.

The Taste of La Costa would not have been possible without the support of some VERY dedicated volunteers, a few equally generous business donors, a plethora of vendors that were willing and happy to donate their wares for our auctions and their menu for this very important evening, and of course you – our guests and auction bidders (our LCC parents, staff and alumni).
