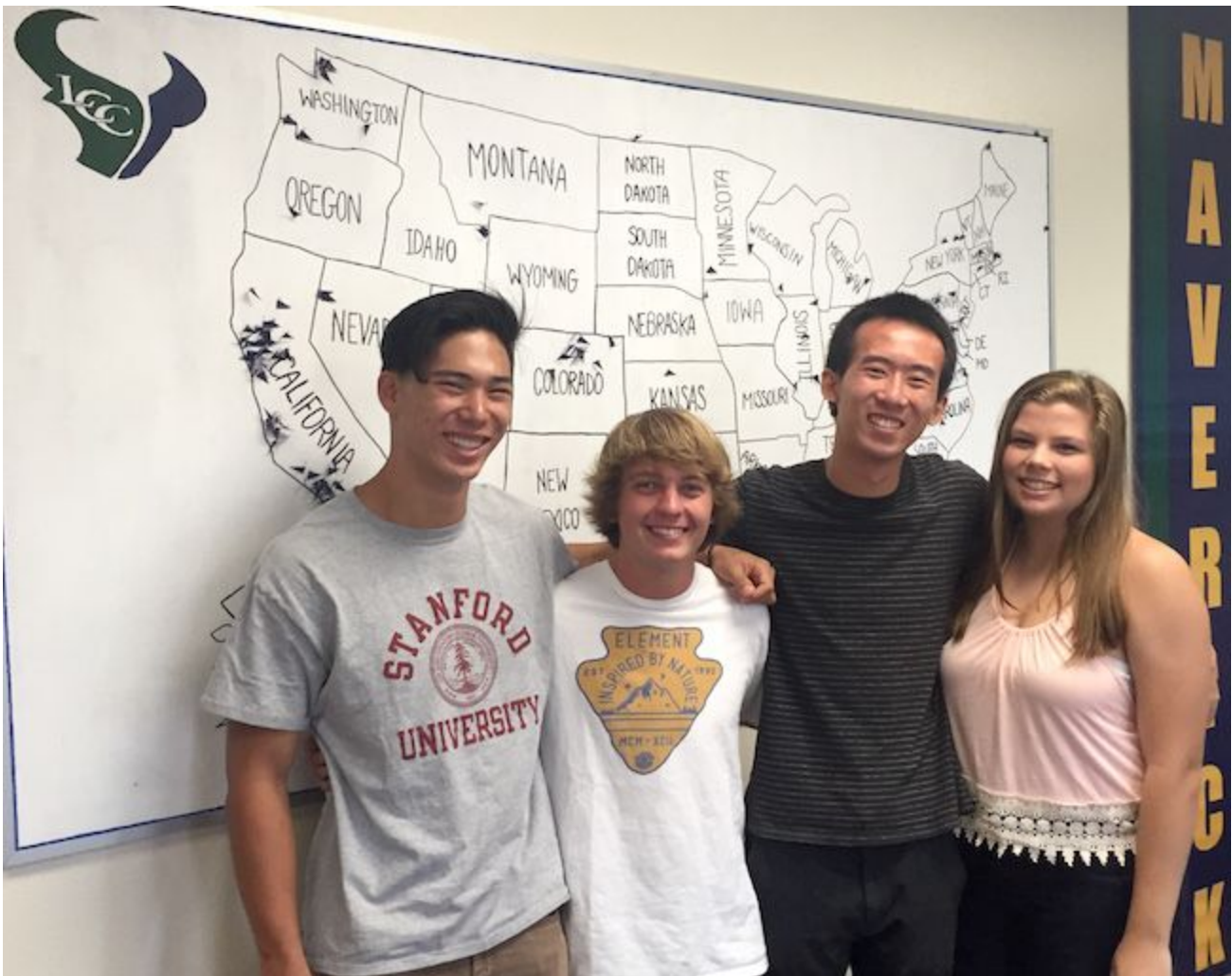

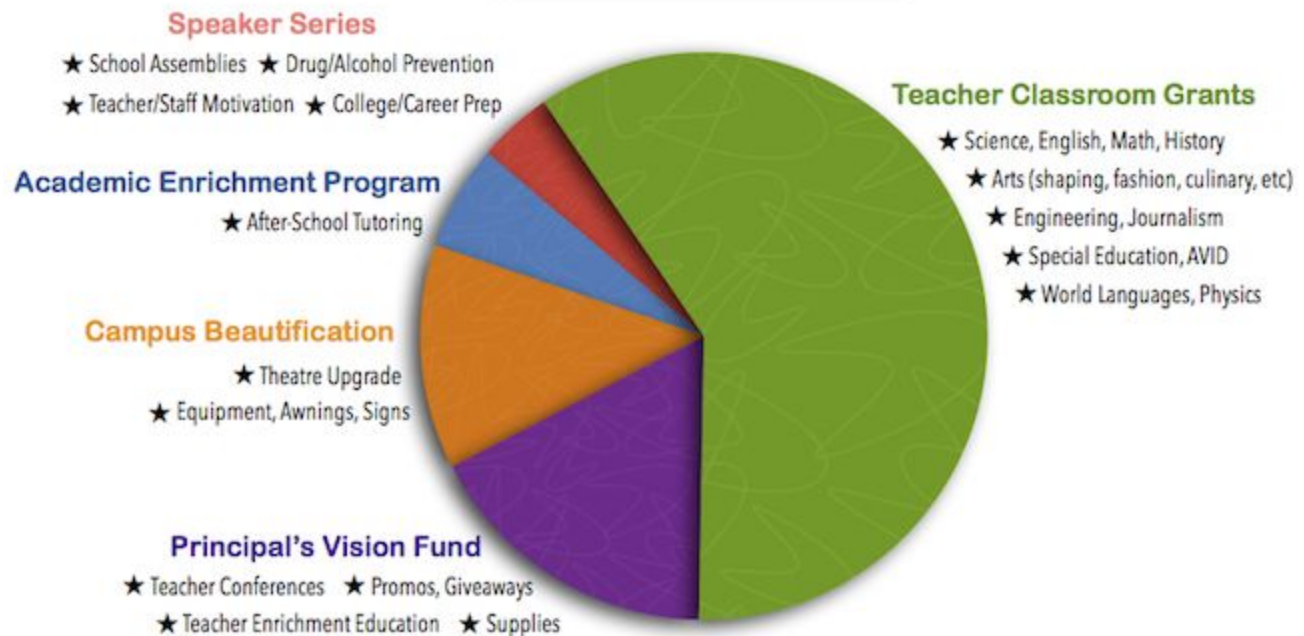
★ What Does the LCC Foundation Do? ★

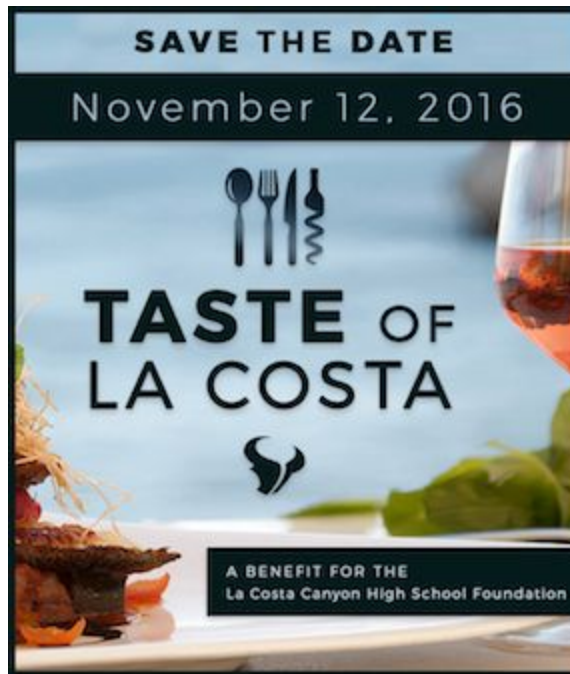
