**Hello LCC Senior Parents,**

November 1st is just over a week away, which means you have just over a week to finalize all gold package and senior ad purchases and submit all ad materials.

We've received tons of questions over the past few weeks, so we created an FAQ page on our site. Check it out at <http://www.lccyearbook.com/faq.html> for immediate answers.

**A few of the most common questions we've received:**

**Q: I forgot if I purchased / What size ad did I purchase?**

A: If you purchased a Gold Package, a yearbook and a half page ad are included. If you've forgotten what or if you purchased, contact the finance office at 760.436.6136 x6144, or check our digital receipt page on [lccyearbook.com](http://lccyearbook.com).

**Q: I already purchased an ad. Do I still need to fill out an order form?**

A: Yes, please do! An order form is separate from payment and helps us insure the accuracy and organization of senior ads. An order form is also how you provide us important details about your ad, such as how you'd like the student name(s) printed, if we should keep the ad a secret from your senior, and if our staff will be designing the ad or if you'll be sending in a completed ad yourself. You can even enter your personal message and upload your digital photos right through the order form.

**Q: Can more than one person share an ad?**

A: Yes, ads can be split between more than one senior. However, one party must purchase the ad and fill out one order form for the group. We will not track down multiple people, multiple purchases, and multiple order forms to combine into one ad. All names, photos, and personal message must fall within the ad specifications.

**Q: What size is an ad? How many photos can be featured? What is the character limit?**

A: A half page ad is 8 inches wide by 5 inches high, can fit up to 7 photos, and has a 200 character limit. A full page ad is 8 inches high by 10 inches wide, can fit up to 14 photos, and has a 400 character limit.

# 50 Days to 125K!

It is hard to believe that it's already the middle of October, but here we are — that means cooler weather (supposedly), pumpkin-spiced everything, holidays around the corner, and football. It also means it's time for an incredible opportunity at LCC.

Last year, for the very first time, we launched a campaign called "50K in 50 Days". Five families stepped forward who were willing to donate up to \$5,000 each! Our goal was for the rest of the LCC community to match that combined \$25,000 donation for a total of \$50,000 in just over a month. The campaign was a rousing success, and we surpassed our \$50,000 goal! 100% of the money raised went directly to our teachers; \$35,000 went to our STEM classes alone. We couldn't have been more excited.

To put into perspective the impact this campaign made: **Just three years ago,** \$50,000 was more than the LCC Foundation raised in parent giving in the entire school year; last year, we did it in just over a month. It truly was incredible that our community was able to grant these additional funds to LCC's dedicated teachers, and they were immensely appreciative.

**This year,** the Foundation Board has set our sights even higher. Our fundraising goal for the 2017-2018 school year is **\$125,000.**

*All five of the families who launched the campaign last year have made the same commitment once again!*

Even better, five **additional** families have pledged to match up to \$5,000, for a total of \$50,000 in matching funds! Cue LCC community. Every single dollar you give towards this campaign will be matched by one of our generous donors.

Ironically, even with the lowest funding, SDUHSD students achieve the highest test scores in the state — and they go on to achieve great things in college and beyond. Our Foundation raises a small percentage of those funds that schools in other districts receive from the state. This money is granted directly to our teachers and administrators, who use the funds to enhance the educational experience of every student at LCC. We have already granted \$40,000 to our teachers this year, but this is less than half of what was requested for first Semester alone!

*Our goal is always to have 100% participation from our community.*

If you can give \$1,000, please consider it; if you can only give \$50, we are grateful for that, too. Whatever you can, and are willing to give, will be matched dollar for dollar and will directly impact your child. If you have questions about the Foundation or what exactly your donations are used for, please contact me. I am happy to outline the details of our grants to date, as well as the unmet needs that we hope to fund through this campaign.

However, districts that serve low-income students receive significant supplemental funds; as a result, our district (SDUHSD) receives less money per student than any other district in the state of California.

»» **Have You Suddenly Stopped Receiving Foundation or SDUHSD Emails?** »»

**It could be your providers' overzealous spam filters.**



The Foundation has recently discovered that TWC/Spectrum roadrunner email accounts are automatically blocking all emails sent from Vertical Response (the Foundation's mass mailing service provider). While Vertical Response works to resolve the issue with TWC/Spectrum, if you would like to continue receiving dedicated emails from the Foundation about upcoming Foundation-sponsored events, please contact [marketing@lchsfoundation.org](mailto:marketing@lchsfoundation.org) to provide an alternate email address.

Likewise, Apple has begun aggressively filtering emails from InTouch, SDUHSD's bulk mail service provider. If your district emails have suddenly dropped off, this could be why. SDUHSD techs are working to resolve the issue ASAP, however, to continue receiving bulk District emails without concern, please log into your **parent Aeries account** and change your Apple email (mac.com, icloud.com, me.com) to an alternate provider (if you have one).

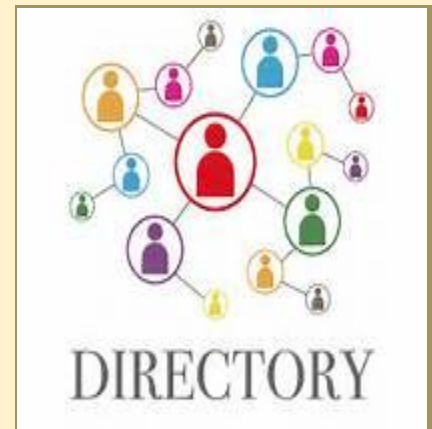
