- The whole school is IB
 - Professional Development
 - Collaboration
- Expectations across all courses



IB Diploma

Referred to as the IB Core:

- Theory of Knowledge (TOK) class junior year
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)
- Extended essay (EE)
 - IB TOK teacher
 - Designated coordinators for CAS and EE



IB Diploma

- Course from each of the following during junior and senior years
 - Language and Literature
 - Sciences
 - Mathematics
 - Individuals and Societies
 - Language Acquisition
 - Arts

- IB Math (SL)
- IB Language and Literature (HL)
- IB Physics (HL)
- Senior Seminar / TOK
- Team PE/Elective/Free Period

*Econ/Gov is a graduation requirement as well. Could be done senior year, or off campus

- Diploma Program Course Results (DPCR)
 - Taking IB Courses
 - 11th and 12th grades



LCCHS as an IB World School

- **IB and AP at LCC Example**
 - AP Language and Composition
 - AP Literature and Composition
 - IB Language and Literature (HL)
 - Students will begin their IB experience their junior year in their AP Lang and Composition
 - Students will begin the IB assessments that they will finish their senior year in AP Lit/IB Lang and Literature
 - Students have the option to take AP exams for both AP English classes

Some IB Data

A 2010 study that looked at performance on IB exams and college GPAs of more than 1,500 IB students enrolled in the University of California system found:

- IB students earned higher GPAs and graduated at higher rates than matched comparison group
- Performance in the IB Programme was the strongest predictor of college GPA
- The average acceptance rate of IB students into university/college is 22% higher than the average acceptance rate of a commensurate population of non-IB students
