League Realignment in 2010-2011

Re-leaguings for athletics is considered every other year by the North County Conference rules. On October 14th, the North County conference principals voted for a new look that includes four leagues starting next fall. For the first time, the conference will include football only leagues with a separate alignment for all other sports. For some schools like LCC, the football league includes the same schools as it does for all other sports; but for other schools, the line-up may be different. In 2010-2011, LCC will be in the Avocado League for ALL SPORTS. The Avocado league will be comprised of Carlsbad, Oceanside, El Camino, Rancho Buena Vista and LCC. Although LCC's long time rival Torrey Pines will be now in the Palomar League, rivalry games will still be considered important to all the school's athletic schedules and all sports want to keep those games intact where the schedule allows. It might not be the final games of the season as in years' past due to league contests but everything will be done to see that the rivalry games still take place on the schedule. According to John Labeta, LCC's Athletic Director, the only sports that might have difficulty scheduling the rivalry games are baseball and possibly softball.
