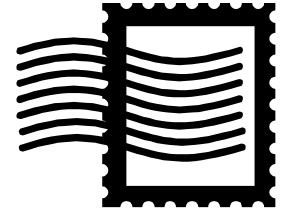

DO NOT CONFUSE THIS PHOTO WITH "SENIOR PORTRAITS" (See below).

Seniors **MUST** have had yearbook photos taken at Keane Studios if they wanted to appear in yearbook. If you did not want to order photos for friends and family, Keane will pick the best of a few poses and submit it directly to the yearbook staff free of charge.

PLEASE NOTE: "SENIOR PORTRAITS" ARE ENTIRELY SEPARATE FROM "SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTOS"

"Senior Portraits" are your decision, as is the studio where you choose to have these portraits done.

"Senior Yearbook Photos" are mandatory only if you wish to appear in the Yearbook. The sitting is free. Yearbook **only uses** senior photos from Keane Studios. Yearbook **does not accept** senior photos from anywhere else.

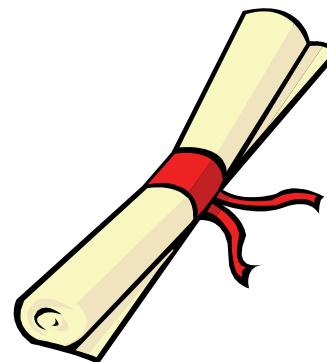

SENIOR BREAKFAST AND SLIDE SHOW

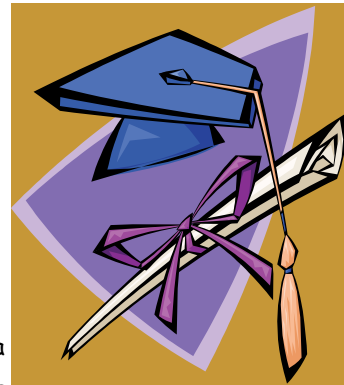
When: Tuesday, **June 10, 2008**—8 a.m.
