Summer 2022: Free Breakfast and Lunch will be offered to students attending in-person summer school and extended school year programs at SDA; free meals are provided regardless of student eligibility for the Free/Reduced Price Meal Program. Students not enrolled in Summer School may visit https://www.cde.ca.gov/ds/sh/sn/summersites22.asp to search a list of locations where children may receive free nutritious meals during summer vacation and off-track periods. Summer Meal Program sites are open to all community children up to 18 years of age.

SY 2022-23: San Dieguito Union High School District (SDUHSD) Nutrition Services will provide school meals at no charge for the 2022-23 school year to all students attending in person. Each student may request a breakfast and lunch free of charge regardless of their eligibility for free or reduced-price meals. Meal applications for the Free/Reduced Meal Program will be available to all households for the 2022-23 school year after July 1, 2022.
