New Supports and School Policies for Students

As a result of feedback from parents, students, teachers, and our community, we are excited to roll out some new policies and supports for our Mavericks.

Here is a snapshot of some of the changes for 2019-20:

- School wide cell phone measures for all classrooms to help increase instructional focus and improve student wellness. Students will be asked to place their cell phones in caddies during class time to avoid distraction, address wellness, and increase focus on instruction.
- Students will no longer be able to loiter in the parking lot during break and lunch. There is no supervision for safety in the parking lot and we are moving to increase our sense of Maverick community on campus during break and lunch. Students will have more tables with umbrellas for seating and more activities during lunch to engage students. This also means students will not be able to use their cars as "lockers." A backpack is recommended to carry all supplies for school.
- Seniors are still allowed to leave campus during lunch. They will need to show their ID to a staff member as they exit the gates of LCC.

Student Drop Off and Pick Up

As we welcome you back, just a reminder on where students get dropped off. We have a couple of areas that our students get dropped off for school:

- 1) By the tennis courts off of Calle Acervo. We will have the gated open for students to walk along the tennis courts, entering by the gym
- 2) Students can be dropped off at the turn around, just remember that this area becomes extremely crowded. Please pack your patience, pull forward, and remember to keep the line moving. This makes it good for everyone
- 3) The upper parking lot is for parking only, not drop off. This becomes a safety issue if students are being dropped off further up the lot than the turn around
