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Good Afternoon Maverick Families!

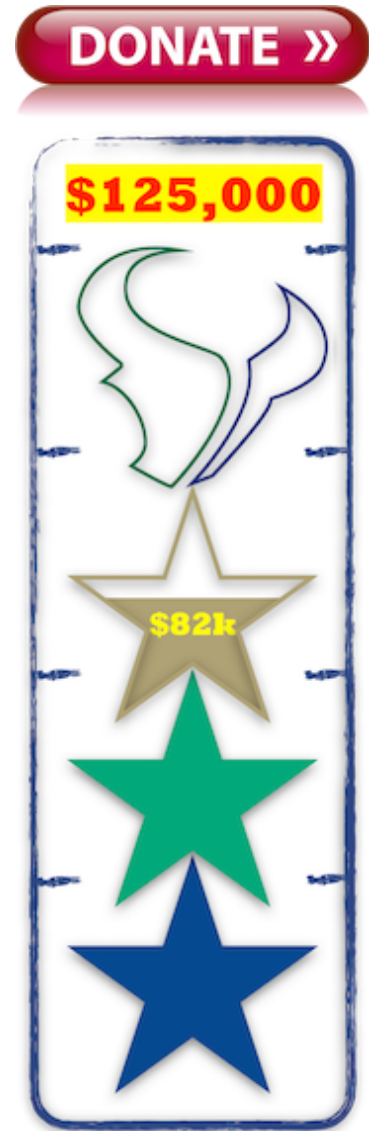
I am so thrilled to inform you that after 2 weeks, our 50 Days to 125K drive now stands at **\$125,000**. Again, this money goes directly to LCC and its teachers and classrooms.
