Learning Commons: Open Daily (before school and after school). Students can work collaboratively or individually on homework or assignments.

CLASS OF 2018 AND CAL GRANT: The California Grant (CalGrant) gives funds to every eligible senior student who meets the requirement. A Cal Grant pays for tuition, room and board or books and other supplies for California colleges. La Costa Canyon will electronically submit GPA information for every senior to the California Student Aid Commission. If you **do not** wish to have your information or your student's information submitted electronically, please fill out, sign and submit the "**Opt-Out**" form attached to this email. This "Opt-Out" form must be submitted by **September 27th, 2017** to the Registrar's office. After this date, the information will be electronically submitted to the California Student Aid Commission. Even though LCC will submit your GPA information for you with no other additional forms required, it is still NECESSARY and REQUIRED to submit a FAFSA.
